By submitting an application, you are indicating, at this point, a willingness to commit to the following for **at least one year**:

- 1. Attend Monday community meetings, trainings, and process groups
- 2. Attend retreats (two per year)
- 3. Contribute to at least one committee (guideline of 5 hours/month)
- 4. Build your client practice

While we understand that life events arise and that goals and priorities change, these commitments are significant as they help us to maintain a thriving organization. We ask that members communicate with the BAGI community if they are unable to attend meetings or trainings, or meet commitments to committee participation.

- 1. Please describe your experience and training in Gestalt psychotherapy.
 - a. List how you have met the criteria for associate prerequisites. Please include the name of the organization under which you completed, or will have completed, the one-year internship or associate program, the dates of your involvement, and the name(s) of, and contact information for, the program's director(s) and manager(s).
 - b. If you participated in a Gestalt Therapy-based group or Gestalt Therapy-based training program, please include the dates of your involvement and the name(s) and contact information for the facilitator(s) or leader(s).
 - c. Similarly, if you have had a Gestalt Therapy-based supervisor, please provide the supervisor's name, license information, contact information, and the dates of your involvement. BAGI will reach out to these points of contact as part of the reference-checking process.

Please note that we will call your supervisor as a reference.

- 3. BAGI is a volunteer-run non-profit that is dependent on active engagement by every member in community and committee meetings.
